Scope of NEARCTIS

with a particular focus on cooperative systems.

The link with gender equality may be twofold:

Applied: are we promoting gender equality
into our research's application?

Research: are we promoting gender equality
into our research production process?



Gender Equality in **applying** our research, What does it mean?

Scope of NEARCTIS:

traffic management and optimisation,
with a particular focus on cooperative systems

- ▶ Are users equal with respect to the use of the cooperative systems (equality of access despite the inequality between the potential users)
- ▶ Have women specific difficulties in accessing to and using cooperative systems?

Probably not, but who knows?

Note: We do not have the scientific knowledge useful to answer this question into the scientific community actually gathered into the NEARCTIS project



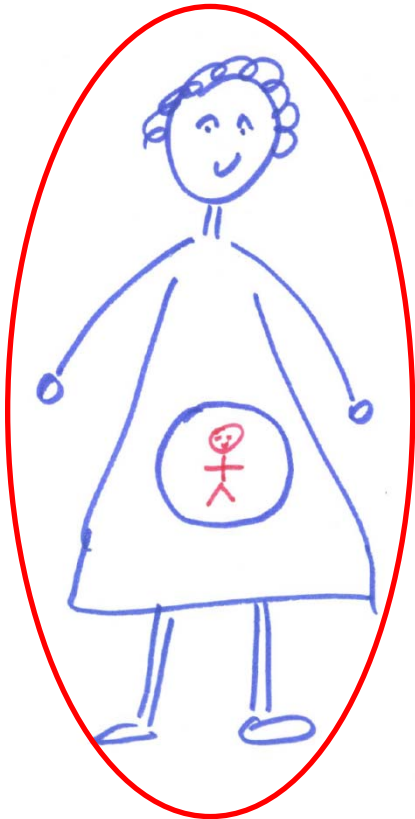
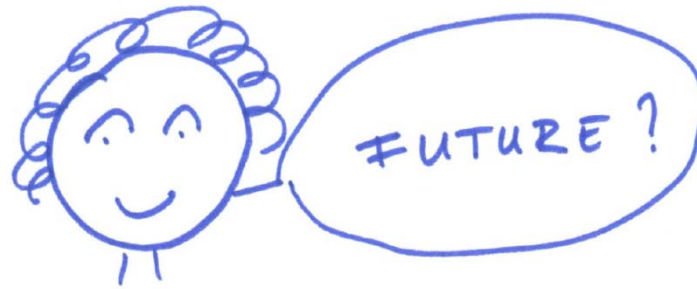
Gender Equality into the **research production process**, What does it mean?

	people	women	percentage
member of NEARCTIS	66	9	14 %
task leaders	22	3	14 %
WP leaders	5	0	0 %

- ▶ Generally speaking, few women work for the scientific fields belonging to the scope of NEARCTIS
- ▶ Most of the women involved into the NEARTIS team are at the beginning of their career
- ▶ The problem is more or less out of the scope of the NEARCTIS project
- ▶ It seems that NEARCTIS as itself do not have any impact on the gender sharing of responsibility.
